A 1993 graduate of Harvard College, Philippe Wamba, in his short life, had a profound impact on his fellow students and the faculty of the Afro-American Studies Department. Following his graduation, he soon returned to Harvard University where he became the Editor-in-Chief of *Africana.com*. Known for his remarkable personality as well as his outstanding intellectual capability, Philippe Wamba's life is celebrated through this prize honoring the best senior thesis in African Studies. A prize of up to five hundred dollars will be awarded.

All African and African American Studies concentrators are automatically eligible for this prize and do not need to submit additional copies of their theses for consideration.

All other seniors must submit the application form, a copy of the thesis, a letter of recommendation from their thesis advisor, thesis reader comments, a one-page abstract of the thesis and a C.V. to our AAAS Undergraduate Studies and ALP Program Coordinator, Barker Center, 2nd Floor, Room 231A.
